Goals

1. Teacher teams to develop common curriculum maps

Review of JSD Wellness policy (AA446)

- Nutrition program must follow guidelines in policy

- We are providing physical fitness education according to the Core curriculum for Physical Fitness. We give actual structured time in the gym with a teacher 40 min/week and they have free time outside twice daily at recess, weather permitting.
- Nutrition and Wellness Oversight Advisory committee overseeing compliance to wellness policy

Snap Plan Change

- Improved crosswalk plan from last year seems to be working.
- Concerns about current SNAP plan
 - Alsia Didenhover - On the east side of the school, off school grounds, some kids are riding bikes in road and on grass to get around other kids, getting close to traffic. Dangerous situation.
 - Amanda - we can have a teacher watch around the corner temporarily
 - Heather Shay is concerned about an area where the sidewalk transitions to dirt. Amanda asked her to send her an email with specifics.
- Amanda - No intention to change SNAP Plan this year due to unknown boundary changes coming for next year.

Kindergarten Playground

- Heather Shay proposed a change to the Kindergarten playground. She expressed her concern that there are too many kids for playground (approximately 160 Kindergartners total - She said she counted 26 on the slide area at once). She is proposing that the fence be extended into the grass area to the west to give them more space. This is primarily a problem before school, when up to 80 kids are there at the same time.
- Harmony Pearce (parent and recess/copy aid) said this is not a big deal because it is only an issue before school - not during recess - because the K classes take recess breaks at different times.
- Amanda will check with the district and get back to the group, and she'll talk to the Kindergarten teachers.
